When the owner is a well known media entertainer it is only logical to create a garden that reflects personality.

The space in the garden had to meet two prime targets: suitable for entertaining with friends; and a place to come home to, shut the door and forget the outside world.

The client's brief was to create a Bali style garden. The result is a garden that, as it grows, will make life easer in terms of maintenance, durability and safety.

As a design and installation company, Botanical Bliss identified a range of plants that would reflect the client's personality and his charming flamboyant celebration of life. Lots of colour in flowers and foliage, a mixture of textures and a changing seasonal ambiance best summed up the character of the landscape.

A gravel entry was broken up by using different gravel products and the soft yellow pavers selected do not retain the heat, unlike darker colours.



In the lawn, pavers are slightly lower to make mowing easier.

Screening unwanted aspects such as the neighbour's house and enhancing the backdrop of a nature reserve adds value to the privacy of the property and maximises the 'borrowed landscape' of the native endemic bushland.

In time the garden plants will grow and the statues will nestle into the site enveloped by the topical flora to create the idyllic sanctuary.

Complementing this tranquil garden is a pond with a contemplation rock for watching the fish.
